Create one following these easy steps.

1. You need a valid email address and your 6-digit account number (physicians) or group number (non-physicians)
2. Go to vantage.svmic.com and click DON'T HAVE AN ACCOUNT
3. Select the account type you wish to create and follow the prompts
4. Your account information will be emailed to the address you provided

2 Register for your course

1. Go to vantage.svmic.com and log into your account
2. Go to the EDUCATION section, select your TYPE OF EDUCATION, then click LEARN MORE
3. Utilize the FILTERS on the left side of the screen to narrow down your choices
4. You can also use the SEARCH BAR at the top of the page to search for a specific course
5. When you see your COURSE TITLE, click the TITLE itself to be taken to the course
6. Click the REGISTRATION tab to register for the course
7. Register by following the prompts on the screen
